**BEASTS OF BURDEN / THINGS LEFT UNSAID**  
**March 9 to May 2, 2021**

Paul Seawright (\* 1965 in Belfast, where he lives and works) is one of Northern Ireland's most internationally renowned photo artists. More than three decades ago he began to photographically explore his homeland, which was marked by the civil war, as a contested space.

At first glance, Paul Seawright's way of working is documentary and clear. Nevertheless, his photo projects, mostly laid out in series, elude quick readability. They focus on details, the context or also on the side scenes of social or political realities, long beyond Northern Ireland, the public perception of which is normally determined by reporting that is strongly oriented towards the event.

Paul Seawright's motifs create a special tension. Photography, a medium that is bound by convention to the visible, is used in all its precision of authentic reproduction. At the same time, however, the photo-
